SUEZ Energy Resources NA to Host ERCOT Energy Summit in Dallas

Texas Business Leaders and Energy Experts Gather to Discuss the Intricacies of the ERCOT Market

HOUSTON – August 25, 2008 – SUEZ Energy Resources NA, the retail energy business of SUEZ Energy North America, will be hosting an educational summit to discuss the specificities of the Texas energy market (ERCOT) on Sept. 24, 2008, in Dallas. The event will provide SUEZ customers and prospects the unique opportunity to exchange ideas with leading industry experts and discuss topics that are at the forefront of the energy market in Texas.

The one-day complimentary summit will feature a variety of industry experts speaking on topics ranging from ERCOT's transition from a Zonal to a Nodal market, to Demand Response services and the Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Program. Speakers include:

- **Andrew Weissman**, Senior Energy Advisor with FTI-Washington, D.C., will present on today's Energy Market Outlook, reviewing political, social and climate changes that are driving energy prices, oil and natural gas;

- **Tim Murray**, LEED AP, Chair, U.S. Green Building Council, will talk about what the LEED Program is and why customers should take note of it; and
- **Orrin Cook**, Senior Analyst with Center for Resource Solutions, will educate attendees on Green Partnership & Labeling, including the benefits of Green-e.

"SUEZ is excited to host its third energy summit," said Gail Workman, regional vice president, ERCOT, SUEZ Energy Resources NA. "We have selected some of the most knowledgeable speakers in the industry, which will allow for a stimulating discussion among our customers, prospects and experts. Attendees will learn about the pertinent topics currently affecting the Texas energy market and as a result, our goal is to help them feel better-informed when it comes to making the decisions that matter about their own energy use."

In addition to SUEZ Energy's lineup of experts, Stephen Jones, COO, Executive Vice President and Director of Personnel with the Dallas Cowboys, will be delivering a keynote focused on risk management. Jones coordinates the Cowboys' entire player personnel department and oversees the negotiation of all player contracts including the management of the salary cap and the operation of the Texas Stadium and is uniquely familiar with risk management within his daily operations. He will put into perspective how customers need to take a proactive role in monitoring their energy needs as a way of mitigating risk associated with today's volatile market.

The summit will kickoff the evening of Sept. 23 when SUEZ will host a complimentary networking event at the Dallas Cowboys Stadium where attendees will have the opportunity to mingle with former Dallas Cowboy, Jay Novacek. The pre-summit kickoff begins at 5:30 p.m. and will take place at the Stadium Club in the Texas Stadium.

SUEZ Energy Resources NA currently serves commercial and industrial customers in 10 states: Delaware, Texas, Massachusetts, Maine, Maryland, New York, New Jersey, Pennsylvania, Illinois, Connecticut and also Washington, D.C. The company serves approximately 30,000 customer accounts, mainly with commercial and industrial customers having peak demands ranging from 50 KW to more than 200 MW, for a total contracted load of 5,000 MW.

SUEZ Energy Resources NA is a subsidiary of SUEZ Energy North America, Inc., which manages a range of energy businesses within the United States, Mexico, and Canada, including electricity generation and cogeneration, natural gas and liquefied natural gas (LNG), asset-based trading and origination, and retail energy sales and related services to commercial and industrial customers.

SUEZ Energy North America owns and/or operates a total of 47 power, cogeneration, steam, and chilled-water facilities, including those in construction, representing a capacity of more than 6,382 MW of electricity generation, 6.0 million pounds per hour of steam, and 41,973 tons per hour of chilled water. SUEZ Energy North America's wholly owned subsidiary, Distrigas of Massachusetts, owns and operates a liquefied natural gas receiving terminal in Everett, Mass., which began operations in 1971 and currently serves most of the gas utilities in New England and key power producers, meeting approximately 20 percent of New England's annual gas demand. In addition, SUEZ Energy North America has an LNG deepwater port under construction off the coast of Massachusetts and another LNG deepwater port project under development off the coast of Florida.
