SUEZ Energy North America concludes sale of 10 US District Heating and Cooling Systems

HOUSTON – SUEZ Energy North America, Inc., a business unit of SUEZ Energy International, one of the business divisions of SUEZ (NYSE: SZE), announced today it had concluded the sale of 10 District Heating and Cooling Systems (“DHCS”) to Thermal North America, a Boston-based private venture focused on investments in DHCS and related investments. The facilities have been operated by Trigen Energy Corporation, an affiliate of SUEZ Energy North America. The sale of these facilities is consistent with the SUEZ business plan calling for the rotation of capital from non-strategic assets into energy assets better integrated with SUEZ Energy North America’s retail energy, LNG regasification, and large-scale power generation business units.

The DHCS assets sold represent a total capacity of 238 MW of electricity generation, 10.0 million pounds per hour of steam and 72,800 tons of chilled water. Facilities are located in New Jersey (Trenton), Maryland (Baltimore (2)), Massachusetts (Boston), Pennsylvania (Philadelphia (2)), Missouri (St. Louis and Kansas City) and Oklahoma (Oklahoma City and Tulsa).

SUEZ Energy North America will continue to own and/or operate 45 power, cogeneration, steam and chilled-water facilities representing a capacity of 5,538 MW of electricity generation, 7.0 million pounds per hour of steam and hot water, and more than 65,000 tons of chilled water. These assets are strategically located to serve major wholesale power markets in the US, including ERCOT, PJM, ISO New York and ISO New England. The company also owns and operates power generation facilities in Mexico and Canada.

Based in Houston, SUEZ Energy North America (formerly named Tractebel North America) is a business unit of SUEZ Energy International (“SEI”) and is responsible for managing SEI’s positions within the energy value chain in the US, Mexico, and Canada, including

electricity generation and cogeneration, natural gas and LNG, asset-based trading and origination, and energy sales and related services.

In addition to its power generation portfolio described above, the company's wholly owned subsidiary, Distrigas of Massachusetts, owns and operates an LNG receiving terminal in Everett, Massachusetts, which currently serves most of the gas utilities in New England and key power producers, meeting approximately 20 percent of New England's annual gas demand. SUEZ Energy Resources NA, the company's wholly-owned US retail energy business, provides cost-effective and reliable electricity and related services to commercial and industrial customers in Texas and select states throughout the Northeast.
